JOSEPH WINSTON CHRISTIAN

September 28, 1949 - December 19, 2022

It is with great sadness and grief that we share the passing of TN Eta brother and long-time volunteer

Joseph Christian. Joe joined SigEp on January 27th, 1973, and is a 2021 Sigma Phi Epsilon Exemplary Service Award recipient honoring his many years of service to our great fraternity. Joe will be truly missed. If you did not have the pleasure of knowing Joe, we recommend reaching out to one of the many brothers that knew him over the years. Obituary: Joe is preceded in death by his father Charles Christian and mother Mildred Mayfield Christian. Joseph Christian was born in Portsmouth, VA September 28, 1949, while his father was in the Navy. Joe lived and was raised mostly in Tennessee, even though his father's Army service resulted in stays at Texas and two trips to Japan. Joe loved being an Army brat and was all boy.
